Combined Terms of Service, Informed Consent, Liability Waiver & Imaging Consent

Please read this document carefully before participating in any Preventa Wellness assessment. By signing below, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by all terms and conditions contained herein.

PART A -- Terms of Service

1. Service Description & Acceptance

Preventa Wellness, LLC ("Preventa") operates a wellness platform that uses proprietary algorithms to generate wellness scores and lifestyle insights. All scores and reports are produced by automated software systems -- NOT by physicians or licensed healthcare professionals. The Preventa platform is a wellness service. It is NOT a medical product, NOT a medical service, and does NOT provide medical advice, diagnosis, or treatment. By signing this agreement, you ("Participant") agree to be bound by all terms herein.

2. Eligibility

By signing, you represent that you are at least eighteen (18) years old and have the legal capacity to enter into this agreement.

3. Wellness Disclaimer

Preventa Wellness is NOT a medical product and is NOT a medical service. Wellness scores, insights, and reports generated by the Preventa platform are algorithm-generated wellness indicators and are NOT medical diagnoses, clinical measurements, or medical advice. Preventa does NOT diagnose, treat, cure, or prevent any disease or medical condition. Results should NOT be used as a substitute for professional medical advice, diagnosis, or treatment. Always seek the advice of a qualified healthcare provider with any questions regarding a medical condition.

4. Intellectual Property

The Preventa Score, all associated algorithms, methodologies, reports, scoring systems, and platform technology are the exclusive intellectual property of Preventa Wellness, LLC. Participant receives a limited, personal, non-transferable license to view their own wellness report. Participant may not reproduce, distribute, reverse-engineer, or create derivative works from Preventa's proprietary technology.

7. Dispute Resolution

Any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of or relating to this agreement, or the breach thereof, shall be settled by binding arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association in accordance with its Commercial Arbitration Rules. The arbitration shall take place in Maricopa County, Arizona. The arbitrator's decision shall be final and binding and may be entered as a judgment in any court of competent jurisdiction.

WAIVER OF CLASS ACTION: Participant agrees that any arbitration or legal proceeding shall be conducted on an individual basis and NOT as a class action, collective action, or representative action. Participant waives any right to participate in a class action lawsuit or class-wide arbitration against Preventa Wellness, LLC.

8. Governing Law

This agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Arizona, without regard to its conflict of law provisions. Any legal action or proceeding not subject to arbitration shall be brought exclusively in the state or federal courts located in Maricopa County, Arizona.

PART B -- Informed Consent & Data Authorization

1. What We Collect

During the assessment, the following data may be collected:

- Lifestyle and behavioral data (self-reported questionnaire responses)
- Physical measurements (height, weight, body composition via bioimpedance)
- Physiological indicators (blood pressure, heart rate)
- Retinal/vessel imaging data (high-resolution images of the retinal vasculature)
- Demographic information (age, sex, relevant health history for scoring context)

2. How Data Is Used

Your data is used for the following purposes:

- Generate your Preventa Wellness Score and personalized wellness report
- Improve and refine Preventa's algorithms and scoring methodology
- Longitudinal tracking to measure your wellness trajectory over time (if you complete multiple assessments)
- De-identified, aggregated research to advance wellness science (your personal identity is never disclosed)
- Sharing with Preventa's affiliated entities, subsidiaries, and related companies for the development and delivery of additional products and services, which may include FDA-regulated medical products
- Sharing with the authorized provider or practitioner who administered your assessment, solely for the purpose of reviewing your wellness results with you

3. Retinal/Vessel Imaging Consent

You may undergo non-invasive retinal imaging as part of the assessment. By signing, you consent to: (a) the capture of retinal images; (b) AI-based algorithmic analysis of your retinal vessel data; (c) storage of images and derived data in Preventa's secure systems in accordance with Preventa's data retention policy.

4. Financial Interest Disclosure & Voluntary Participation

Your administering provider may have a direct or indirect financial interest in Preventa Wellness, LLC (e.g., ownership, investment, or compensation). Arizona law (A.R.S. 32-1401) requires physicians to disclose such interests.
